1. Welcome to the Easter Camp for the Youth Academy

The IAB Summer Youth Academy is taught in English and takes place over 3 days for children aged 8 – 15.

2. Dates and times – April 2023

The three-day Easter course will last 4 hours each day and be filled with acting, singing, dancing, games and lots of fun!

Classes will run from 9:30 – 13:30. We ask that all students arrive by 9:20 am.

Students will be required to attend classes each day.

Classes will take place within the IAB's world class facilities in Sitges, Barcelona.

3. Our teachers

Our fantastic team of teachers have one aim – to bring out the best in each student.

Classes will be taught by experienced and talented staff who are committed to ensuring that the health, safety and happiness of each student is of utmost importance.

All teachers have professional performance experience, general education experience and between them can speak Spanish, English and Catalan.

4. Dress code

Children should wear comfortable clothing, including:

- T-shirt
- Track suit bottoms or leggings
- Trainers
- Extra socks or gym shoes
- Girls hair must be off the face and the back of the neck
- Hats and jewelry are not worn for health and safety reasons
- Sun cream for classes in the courtyard and during the breaks (as appropriate)

5. Snacks & refreshments

Please ensure that your child brings along a snack and drink for the break times. As we may have some students with severe allergies, can we please ask parents not to include nuts or products containing nuts (including sesame snacks).

We have filtered water available at all times for students.

Please note that lunch will not be provided.

6. Code of Conduct

We ask that:

- Children arrive promptly each day at 9:20 am to the registration point (Main door of IAB).
- Children attend every class.
- If a student is unable to attend class, parents/ guardians are required to contact IAB via youthacademy@iabarcelona.es and where possible, provide 24hrs notice of the students absence.

A register will be taken at the beginning of each lesson.

7. Sickness

It is essential that children who are unwell or experience any of the following symptoms, remain at home:

- Temperature/ fever
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Nasal congestion

- Sore throat
- Stomach ache
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Physical discomfort
- Muscle pain
